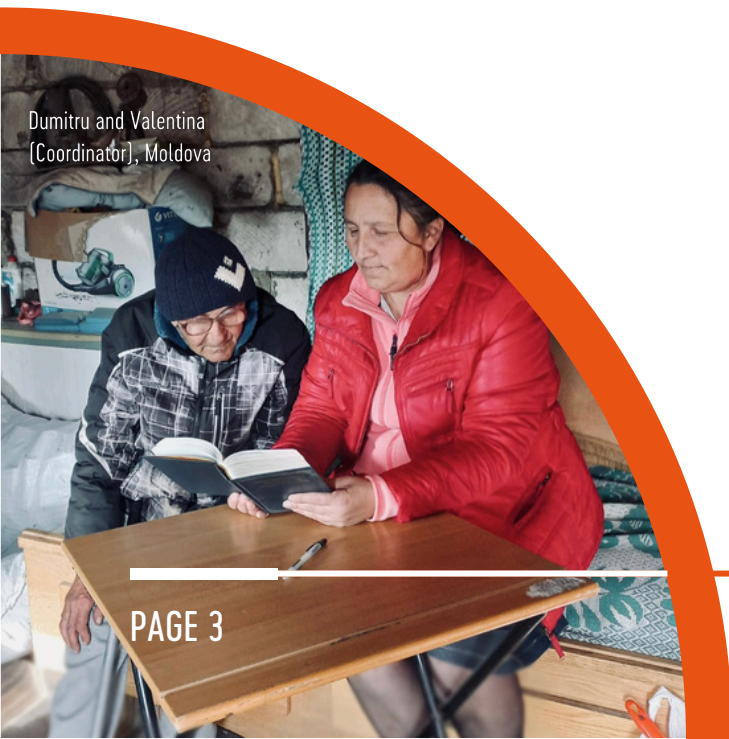
07-08
